RE: Executive Summary – Proposal to Delete the Minor in Community Health Education

The University Curriculum Committee approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate consideration the attached proposal from the Department of Health Sciences for the disestablishment of the Minor in Community Health Education.

The Department of Health Sciences indicated that the Minor in Community Health Education has had very low enrollments over the past several years – fewer than five students at any time. Several years ago, the department began offering the Minor in Public Health which they say is a more relevant option for students. They stated that any student who would benefit from the Minor in Community Health Education will be well-served by the Minor in Public Health.

The University Curriculum Committee supports the proposal to delete the Minor in Community Health Education.
