The new distance dietetic internship will be a 10-credit hour Certificate Program. Students will complete 1,296 hours of supervised practice during rotations in community nutrition, medical nutrition therapy, and foodservice while taking FCS 498 in the fall and spring semesters. Additionally, students will take FCS 402 online during the fall and spring semesters to meet accreditation requirements to cover various required student learning outcomes. This program will be a distance program. Students will set up their rotation sites with approval from the program director. The current dietetic internship/master's program will continue as is.
