# Part A Program Description and Explanations

Responsible department or administrative unit: School of Music

Proposed program title: BA in Music with a Sequence in Musical Theatre

Date of implementation: Fall 2002

#### **Summary of proposed action:**

Those students interested in musical theatre need to first have a solid background in music. It is for this reason that the existing BA in Music curriculum should be the point of departure. It is also agreed that appropriate courses in theatre and dance would be designated in the 24 hours of electives currently found in the BA program to achieve the following: BA in Music with a Sequence in Musical Theatre.

#### Catalog copy for sequence being added:

## **BA** in Music Sequence in Musical Theatre

2 hrs of Theatre Practicum (THE 102) and 2 hrs of Opera Practicum (MUS 165) **NOTE:** This may be 4 of the 8 hours in music performing organizations required of BA in Music majors.

A qualifying performance audition is required for all incoming students needing to enroll in THE 105, 106, 119, and 120. Students who are deficient in dance technique may have to take courses at a lower level. Deficiency hours will be above the hours required for this sequence. Information concerning qualifying auditions is available from the School of Theatre.

#### Therefore, 110 hours are designated in the 120-hour BA program

#### **Rationale for proposal:**

A contract major in Music Theatre has been available at Illinois State University for some years. The Schools of Theatre and Music have been discussing the issue of how best to deal with Musical Theatre, agreeing that the contract major did not provide students adequate musical preparation. After consulting with appropriate faculty in their two units, Fergus Currie, Director of the School of Theatre, and James Major, Director of the School of Music, have agreed that this proposal is the best way to proceed. (See attached letter from Tad Currie, Director of the School of Theatre) The existing BA/BS in Music curriculum (40 hours) is the musical core of the proposed program, with the addition of sixteen (16) hours in theatre and eight (8) hours in dance. The addition of this sequence to the School of Music program offering will also attract new students to Illinois State and result in an increased number of students in the BA/BS in Music.

The addition of this sequence will also increase the number of students enrolled in the BA/BS in Music degree programs.

#### **Impact of the proposal**:

#### Expected impact of proposal on existing campus programs -

The addition of this sequence will not result in existing music programs to be under enrolled. Also, the addition of the sequence will result in an increased number of students enrolled in the BA/BS in Music degrees.

#### Expected curricular changes including new courses -

None will be required since the proposed sequence will use courses already in existence.

#### **Sufficient Milner resources -**

No new library resources will be required.

#### **Anticipated staffing -**

Additional faculty/staff will not be required.

#### Anticipated funding needs and source of funds -

Increased funding will not be required since new courses are not involved, nor a dramatic increase in enrollment is anticipated.
