**Rationale:** The Physical Education-Teacher Education program, in conjunction with the College of Education, requested that the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) remove the Sequence Program of study leading to a 6-12 Standard Certificate in May, 2005. The Physical Education-Teacher Education program director was notified on September 22, 2005 of the IBHE approval of this request.

The removal of the 6-12 program was primarily requested from a student marketability perspective. <u>One course</u> separated the student from receiving a K-12 teaching certificate versus a 6-12 teaching certificate. Removal of the 6-12 option provides greater job placement opportunities for our graduates.
