Description: Delete unused M.A. degree option.

Summary of Proposed Deletion

This proposal would delete the M.A. degree option from the Department of Mathematics' graduate school offerings. All master's degrees awarded by the Department of Mathematics in the last 10 years have been M.S. degrees; no M.A. degrees have been awarded since the University changed the foreign language criteria for this degree. This deletion proposal would merely make official the elimination of a degree that is not currently in use.
