RE:	Proposal to Delete Minor in Comparative Literature

The University Curriculum Committee has approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached proposal to drop the Minor in Comparative Literature from the *Undergraduate Catalog*. This proposal was approved by the University Curriculum Committee on November 12, 2008.

The minor was originally proposed in 2002-2003, jointly by the departments of English and Languages, Literatures, and Cultures. Both departments are in agreement that the minor should be deleted. The rationale provided is that they have been unable to recruit students into the minor and the core courses and electives did not attract enough students. Subsequently, the core courses: ENG/LAN 256, 257, 258 and 259 have already been deleted from the undergraduate catalog due to lack of enrollment.

The University Curriculum Committee supports the proposal to delete the Minor in Comparative Literature.
