RE:	Proposal to Delete the Minor in Journalism for Teacher Education

The University Curriculum Committee has approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached School of Communication proposal to delete the Minor in Journalism for Teacher Education.

The School of Communication's rationale for the deletion of the Minor in Journalism for Teacher Education is that there has been no student interest in the minor in six or more years. The University Curriculum Committee approves the deletion of the minor because with the revision of State of Illinois requirements for endorsements to teaching certificates, teacher education minors no longer correspond to endorsement requirements, nor do they necessarily lead to a teaching credential.

If approved by the Academic Senate, the Minor in Journalism for Teacher Education will be removed from the 2012-2014 Undergraduate Catalog.
