RE:	Proposal to Delete the Minor in Spanish for Teacher Education

The University Curriculum Committee has approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached Department of Languages, Literatures, and Cultures proposal to delete the Minor in Spanish for Teacher Education.

The Languages, Literatures, and Cultures Department is requesting the deletion of the Minor in Spanish for Teacher Education because it no longer plays a role in teacher certification. The minor does not adequately prepare students for the oral proficiency exam or Content Test to receive an endorsement on their teaching certificate. In the past, students with 32 credits in Spanish did not need to take the Content Test; this has now changed.

If approved by the Academic Senate the Minor in Spanish for Teacher Education will be removed from the 2012-2014 Undergraduate Catalog.
