RE: Proposals for Deletion of the Family and Consumer Sciences Sequences

The University Curriculum Committee has approved and is forwarding for Academic Senate review the attached Department of Family and Consumer Sciences proposals to delete the Apparel Merchandising and Design Sequence; Food, Nutrition and Dietetics Sequence; Human Development and Family and Resources Sequence, and the Interior and Environmental Design Sequence from the Major in Family and Consumer Sciences.

The Department of Family and Consumer Sciences replaced the sequences in the Major in Family and Consumer Sciences with new degree programs. The new Major in Food, Nutrition and Dietetics, Major in Human Development, Major in Interior Design, and Major in Fashion Design and Merchandising were approved by the Academic Senate on November 25, 2014 and notification of the approval by the Illinois Board of Higher Education was received on September 23, 2015. It is now possible to remove the sequences from the catalog and the record keeping systems.

If approved by the Academic Senate the sequence will be removed from the *2016-2018 Undergraduate Catalog*.
